That's the average dollar value in recent years of NAHB services and advocacy victories – roughly \$6,200 per housing start for a typical home builder. This number represents the value per housing start a typical builder will see in 2025 as a result of NAHB's efforts on behalf of its members. While some members will experience more of these benefits than others, all will experience the rewards of this work. Among the advocacy victories achieved last year:

LEGAL VICTORY I. NAHB enjoyed a major win in the U.S. Supreme Court case of Sheetz v. El Dorado County. The court ruled that improper impact fees are not made valid just because they are authorized by state legislation.

LEGAL VICTORY II. NAHB saw an even bigger victory with the Supreme Court's decision in the case of Loper Bright Enterprises v. Raimondo. The court's ruling means that federal agencies now have less discretion to impose new regulations that Congress did not clearly authorize. NAHB had sought these legal outcomes in these two cases for many years.

LEGISLATIVE TRIUMPH. NAHB played a major role in saving Job Corps and ensuring this critical workforce development program remained fully funded.
